Our notifications system helps you keep track of your events, keeping it all in one easy place! You can further organize your notifications by reading and/or deleting them.

## How to Read Notifications

1. Click the Envelope button on the top right to access your Notifications on the Notifications tab.



2. Once you've opened the Notifications tab, you can scroll through your messages. Click the envelope icon on unread notifications to mark them as read.
